Dillard, Joyce	General Comment	Public	<p>This document [ULARA SNMP TM-1] only covers the adjudicated groundwater basins in the Upper Los Angeles River but omits those areas not under court order and those Water Rights awarded by the State Water Resources Control Board.</p> <p>There appears to be areas below the monitoring station whose groundwater rights belong to the property owners.</p> <p>Also, in this same region, LA River Water Rights were awarded to Lauren Bon A032212. Ms. Bon plans to distribute water to neighboring parks including the installation of a pipeline under the North Spring Street Viaduct Widening and Rehabilitation Project to service parks on the other side of the river.</p> <p>How are these areas being incorporated in the Upper LA River Watershed?</p> <p>[Various documents related to the Lauren Bon water rights issue were included as part of the comment]</p>	<p>After discussion with the commenter via a phone call, the ULARA Watermaster determined that the areas of interest mentioned in the comment (both the "area below the monitoring station" and the area in which rights "were awarded to Lauren Bon") are located outside of the ULARA Watershed boundary, and outside of jurisdiction of the ULARA Watermaster. The area of the commenter's interest is in fact located in the unadjudicated portion of the Central Groundwater Basin that lies just south of the ULARA Watershed boundary. As such, the commenter was referred to the Central Basin Watermaster. No change to TM-1 was made as a result of this comment.</p>
